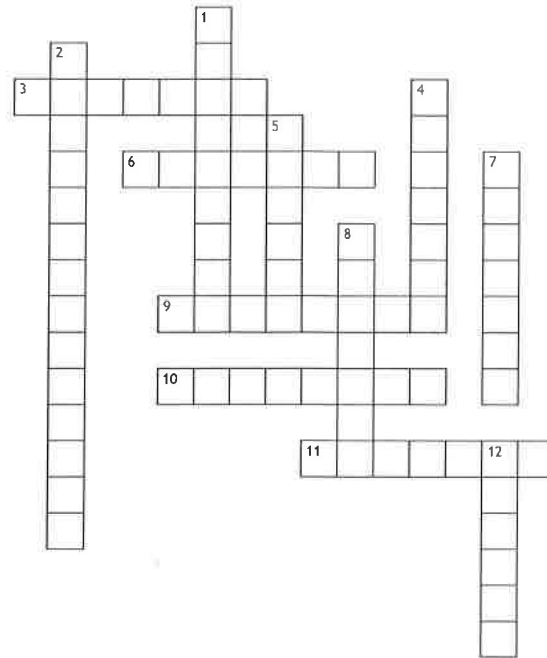
The following vocabulary words will help you to understand directions as presented on the M-STEP. On the weekly quiz, you will be expected to write the definition for each vocabulary word.
