You must also ILLUSTRATE your poems. *Example: Fun in the sky. fly Laps around clouds. Yes! I'm free</p>	<p>Number the alphabet from 1-26. Example: a=1, b=2, c=3, d=4, etc. Then convert your words to a number code. You must write the actual spelling word next to the "code word." Example: 23 + 15 + 18 + 11 = work</p>
